Some of the earliest postage stamps that actually had bicycles or tricycles on them were German local stamps issued in the late 1880's. These issues were from the three states of Bochum, Frankfurt/Main, and Hamburg (Hammonia). In 1892, near the end of the private-post era, Altona overstruck stamps of Hammonia with "Altona" for use within that area

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS RELATING TO AN UNUSUAL PHILIPPINE FIND

In an effort to find out more about an Official Philippine Registry Notice Card franked with a pair of cycling stamps issued in 1981, I had submitted an inquiry to Eugene Garrett who is the President of the International Philippine Philatelic Society (IPPS). In the fourth quarter 1990 issue of IPPS NEWS appeared my question and a corresponding answer, and I am sharing this piece of information herewith;

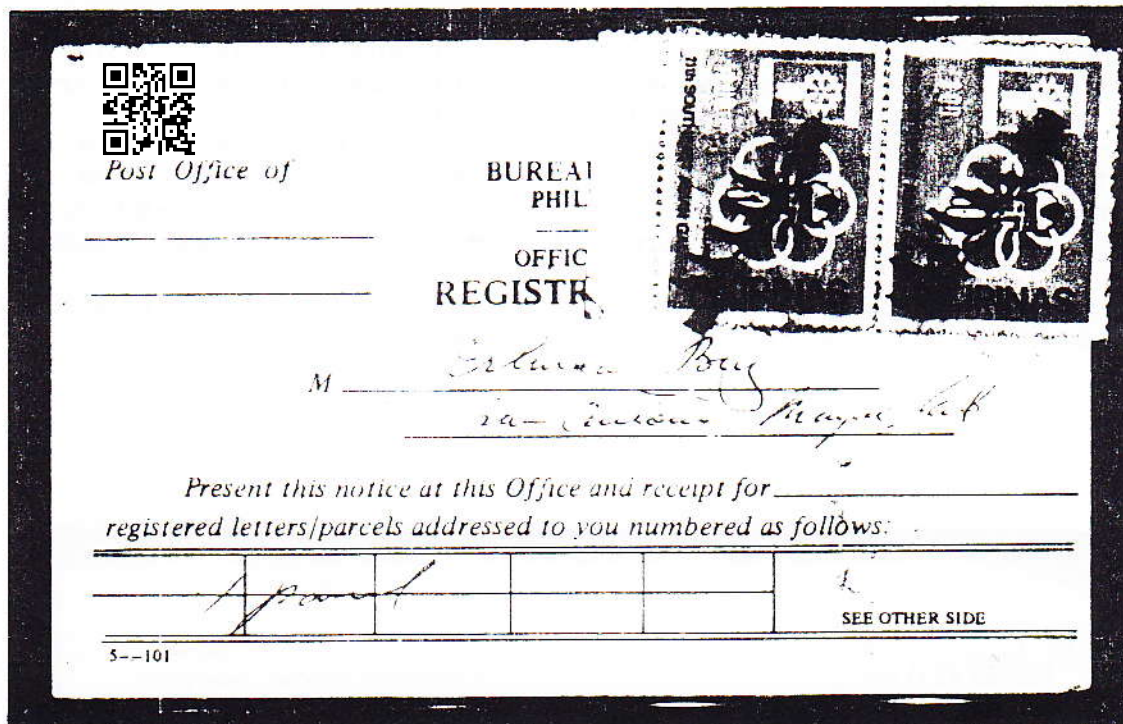

Q15. In searching for material for my thematic collection of bicycles on stamps, I have discovered the Official Registry Notice illustrated in Figure 5 bearing a pair of the ₱1.00 cycling stamp issued in 1981; a similar card is dated March 3, 1982. My question is, what's the purpose of the two ₱1.00 stamps on this Registry Notice? Aren't such Registry Notices normally sent free?

A15. Registry Notices, per se, are postage-free, as they are delivered to the addressee by the post office free of charge. However, to claim the registered mail matter, the addressee must present the Notice at the specified window or post office, where certain mail matters are assessed a handling charge or service fee which is collected by the purchase of postage stamps in appropriate value which are then affixed to the Notice and cancelled, as on the example illustrated in Figure 5.

From 1980 to 1984, when the postage rate for local mail was 40s, the fee was ₱2.00, as shown in the illustrated Notice. Usually, the stamps are affixed to the back side of the Notice, but of course other postal clerks will paste them on the front. Since the rate change when the local postage rate became 60s, the fee was increased to ₱3.25, up to now, the fee remains the same.

Complicating my explanation is the fact that not all registered letters are charged this fee; only big pieces, packets and larger packages or heavy pieces like books, plus all parcels and letters which are diverted to the Parcel Post Division. Also, all registered mail matters which

have customs declaration labels affixed. In the last instance, often it is up to the discretion of the clerk. I often can get away without paying the ₱3.25 charge. However, at times there will be a note written on the notice itself saying "attach or affix ₱3.25 in stamps". Then I always have to pay.

I am not sure exactly what items are charged this fee, but definitely all items we have to claim at the Parcel Post Division; all registered mail with customs labels; some unregistered mail matters bearing the customs label; plus some big pieces, registered or not.

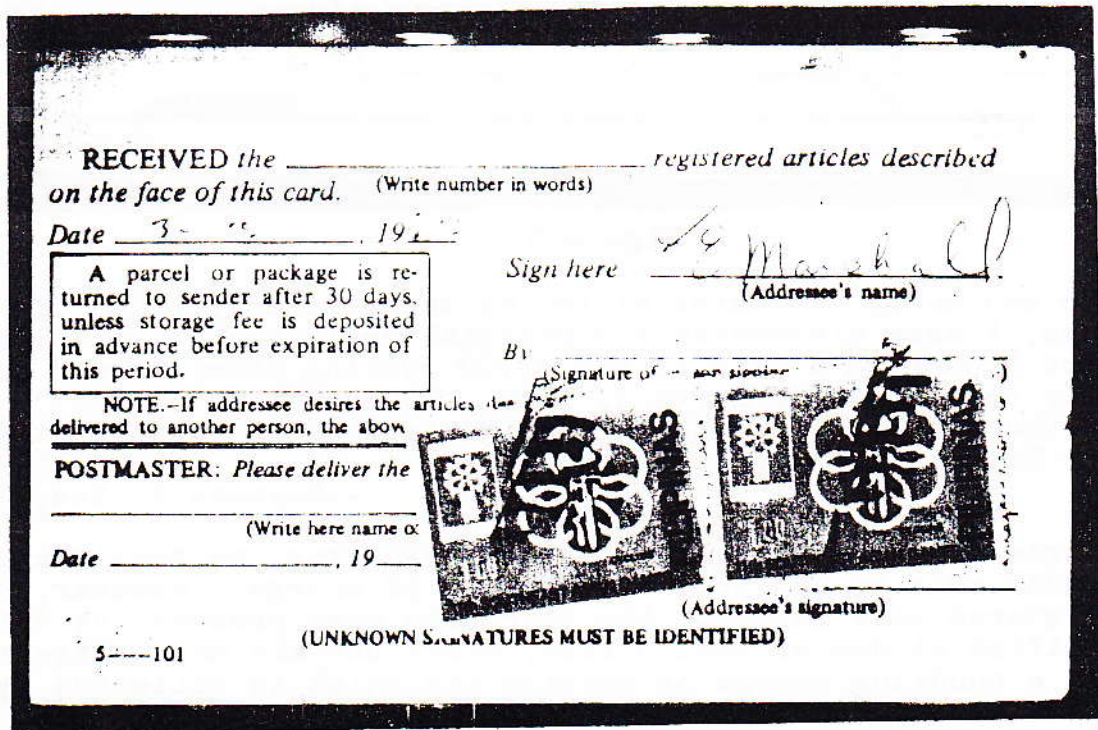

CONCLUSION

I am indeed very grateful to the eminent Dr. Ngo Tiong Tak T. who is better known as the father of modern Philippine Philately for providing me with such a detailed answer to my inquiry.

In essence, Dr. Ngo's reply is that the bicycle stamps on this card were not used to pay POSTAGE; ie, the fee for the conveyance of letters, cards or packages by post. Rather, these stamps were used more likely as REVENUES; ie, income of a government derived from taxes, customs and services etc.

Hence the usage of the two ₱1.00 stamps on this Registry Notice can be described as scarce, proper and unusual.
