

The following two issues were reported in BS13A but are questionable: The Cuba issue pictures a scene inside a velodrome, but shows neither a


bicycle, cyclist, nor part of the velodrome. The Thailand issue was reported in the American press, but may have been a belated report of a 1991 issue.

Scouts' card delivery service will boost funds

COLCHESTER Scouts are running a fundraising Christmas postal service.

The service, which is being co-ordinated by the 34th Colchester Group, offers to deliver mail within the borough boundary, including Mersea Island, in time for Christmas.

The service runs until December 17 with special post boxes dotted around the area, including one at the town hall. To use the service, just drop in your mail and 10p a letter. Do not include stamps.

THE 1992 COLCHESTER SCOUTS' CYCLE MAIL

The third year of operation of the Colchester Scouts' Cycle Mail again saw the issue of 10, 20, and 50 pence stamps. The design shows a front view of Colchester Castle, the finest and largest Norman Keep in the U.K., befitting the stature of Britain's oldest recorded town, the pre-Roman CAMULODUNUM.

This year an increased demand was experienced for the 10p. postal stationery envelope and the convenience of not having to affix stamps to firms' Christmas greetings circulated by small businesses was appreciated by all concerned. The use of the post more than doubled this year and small packets were left for delivery(20p. &50p) as well as letters of all sizes.

The post was again run by Mr. & Mrs. Dave Hampton of the 34th Colchester Group. They did all the stamping, sorting, and also made some of the deliveries. The basic charge was again 10p. per letter, which was left in the collecting boxes with the mail, generally wrapped in plastic bags. Larger items were accepted in the shops/offices by hand, together with the charge or donation to the scout funds.

Six Colchester Scout Groups and one from Mersea Island delivered the mail, after it was sorted and stamped. were the 1st, 7th, 8th, 9th, 34th, and 36th, Colchester, and the 1st Mersea Troop. Mersea, both West and East, being a large island was particularly suitable for the operation of a local post, partly owing to the fact that the Strood approach from the mainland is often flooded at high tide, and all mail leaving the island is routed via Colchester, the main exit from this part of the coast. The area of delivery was within the Colchester town boundary and Mersea Island. Villages just outside this area such as West Bergholt, Birch, Tiptree, Ardleigh, Marks Tey, Wivenhoe (whose scouts ran their own post this year), and Boxted were specifically excluded. A few letters addressed to villages further afield were posted on via the Royal Mail. Likewise, mail to different parts of the country was delivered to the Head Post Office by the scouts. All these covers carried the Scout and Royal Mail stamps.

Every year in the last ten that I have been associated with local posts in this area, odd letters have found their way into the Royal Mail through various reasons and attracted "To Pay" labels, and this year was no exception.


Mail was handstamped with a rectangular "34th. Colchester/Scout Group/Christmas Mail," and date, but owing to the pressures of work, date tamping was discontinued as was the affixing of stamps at times. It should be recorded that as the numbers of letters built up, a second printing of 10p. stamps became necessary, some of which were not printed with the 10p. gold added, but the numbers of these were not recorded. The mail ran from the 8th - 17th December, inclusive, and the number of items carried was in excess of 6,100. Twelve cardboard pillar boxes were used for the post.

The deliveries were carried out by the scouts and cubs (with their parents), and it is felt that not only does it give them an interest and responsibility, but also and introduction to philately and cover collecting.
