There were 4 bicycle exhibits in Philakorea 2002 -

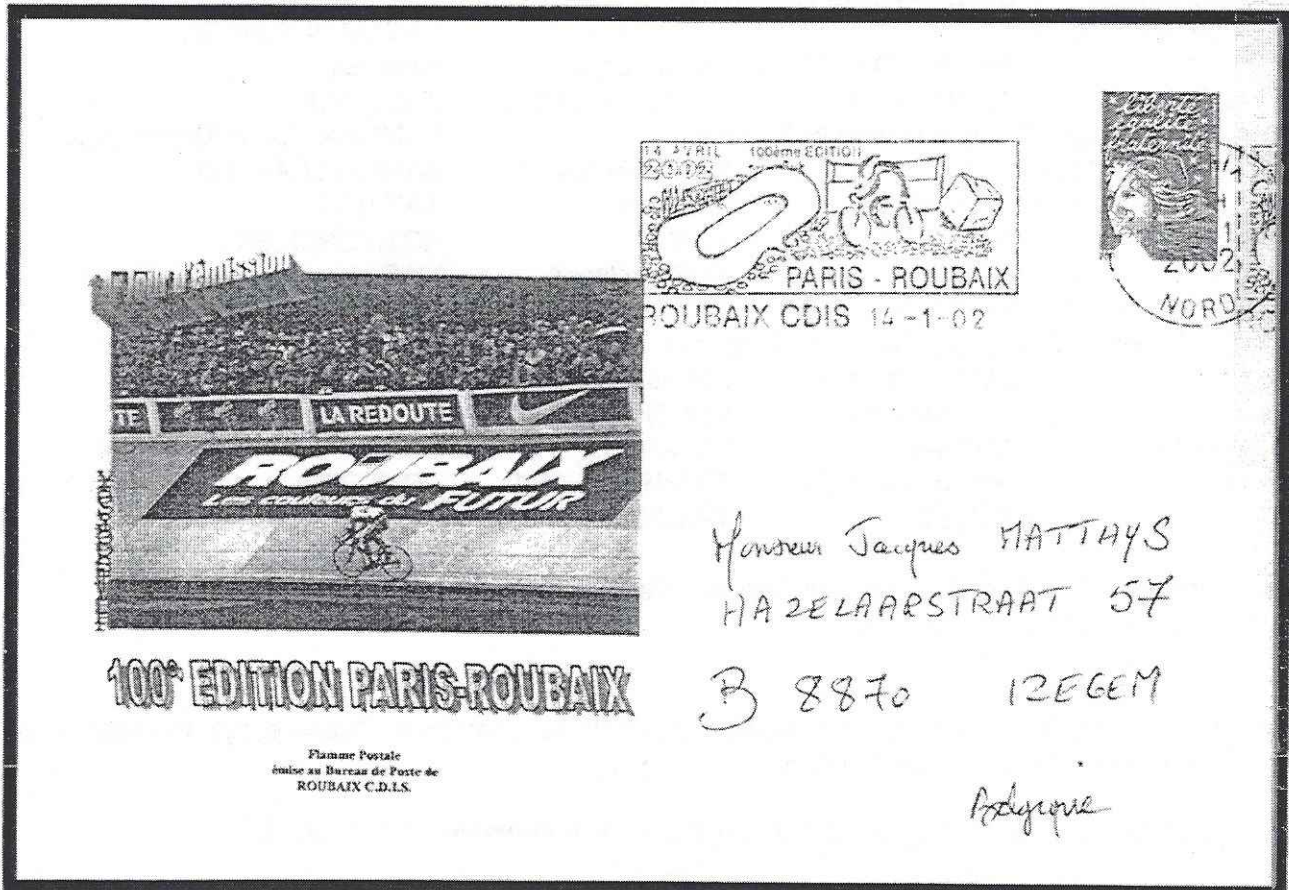
- "Cycling - the world of pedals" Peter Osusky of Slovakia (non-member BSC), Vermeil medal;
- "The history of the bicycle" Inge Johansen of Norway (?ex-member BSC), Large Silver medal;
- "Bicycle evolution and use" Stasa Brasic Youth entrant of Slovenia, Silver medal;
- "Go by Cycle" Brian Sole, Large Vermeil medal.

The judges check for forged items and illegal issues and deduct marks for any items found. Apparently 6 entries had forged Greece Olympic stamps of 1906 and I believe one of the suspect items was found in the bicycle entry "Cycling - the world of pedals".

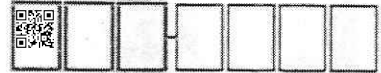
I was pleased to meet Jari Majander of Finland again and we spent a lot time discussing my entry and then photocopies of his entry, which will be displayed at International Stamp Exhibition "Amphilex 2002" in the Netherlands (30 August to 3 September).

There was a meeting of the FIP Congress during the Exhibition. A report on the progress of the World Numbering System set up by WADP (BS38 Feb 2002 item on p.30 "From my Musette"), informed us that 102 Postal Administrations have signed up to this system."

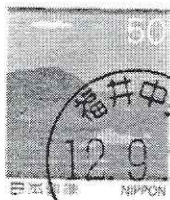
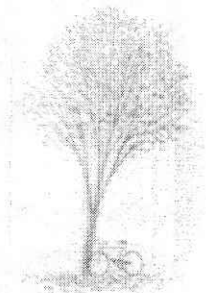

Of these, the most frequently visited is "Stamp Café, a Stanley Gibbons' site. I check this to find new issue information. It is quite simple - after opening the website I select "Sport" as a theme and, when this page come us, I select "CYCLING", this shows initially the most recent issues but, by entering the year of issue at the top of the page, you can access the previous ten years' issues. I then go back to the entry screen and change the topic to "Transport-Land", when this pages comes up, I select "BICYCLE".

I also subscribe to the "Topica" site created by Russ Bissett. I have selected to have any information added to the site to appear on my email list so I do not need to access the website too often. Despite giving all the details for this excellent site in BS37 (From my Musette Page 30) and a reminder in BS39 (FMM Page 26), only 7 of our members have joined. Those that joined have enjoyed swapping "wants" and "duplicates" lists and Jari Majander listed some very interesting details of Finnish Military postcards and a booklet. The site could and should be used by more members.

A site that is very useful is philatelicbureau.com which lists Postal, Email and Website addresses for most countries. I have used it often - only last week, after Paul Braman sent me details of a new Norfolk Island stamp, I used this site to first view the website and then used it again to obtain the email address so that I could contact the Norfolk Island PO to check some details.

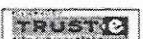




