






Post Office First Day Cover

Edinburgh 1970






# PALAU-JAPAN FRIENDSHIP BRIDGE





The Palau Government appropriated \$3.5 million in December 1996 to construct a temporary floating bridge, which was completed in 1997. Palau received assistance from the Japanese Government in the form of a \$25 million Grant Aid Project to build a new permanent cable-stay bridge with a total length of 412.7 meters between Koror and Babeldaob. Completion of the bridge is slated for december 2001, with the official opening scheduled for January 11, 2002.

The new bridge, newly referred to as the Palau-Japan Friendship Bridge, will once again connect eleven of Palau's sixteen states by land. This edifice so aptly named, symbolizes the friendship between Palau and Japan. 





I hope you are all happy with our choice, we hope to continue the issue of cards annually and, early in 2003, we will be looking for a suitable bicycle-related postcard.

"Go by Cycle" Brian Sole, Large Vermeil medal.


The judges check for forged items and illegal issues and deduct marks for any items found. Apparently 6 entries had forged Greece Olympic stamps of 1906 and I believe one of the suspect items was found in the bicycle entry "Cycling - the world of pedals".





It is quite simple after opening the website ! select "Sport" as a theme and, when this page come us. select "CYCLING", this shows initially the most recent issues but, by entering the year of issue at the top of the page, you can access the previous ten years' issues. I then go back to the entry www.dinter-stamps.com screen and change the topic to "Transport-Land", when this pages comes up, I select "BICYCLE".

l also subscribe to the "Topica" site created by Russ Bissett. I have selected to have any information added to the site to appear on my email list so I do not need to access the website too often. Despite giving all the details for this excellent site in BS37 (From my Musette Page 30) and a reminder in BS39 (FMM Page 26), only 7 of our members have joined. Those that joined have enjoyed swapping "wants" "duplicates" lists and Majander listed some very interesting details of Finnish Military postcards and booklet. The site could and should be used by more members.

A site that is very useful is philatelicbureau.com which lists Postal, Email and Website addresses for most countries. I have used it often - only last week, after Paul Braman sent me details of a new Norfolk Island stamp, I used this site to first view the website and then used it again to obtain the email address so that I could contact the Norfolk Island PO to check some details.


