

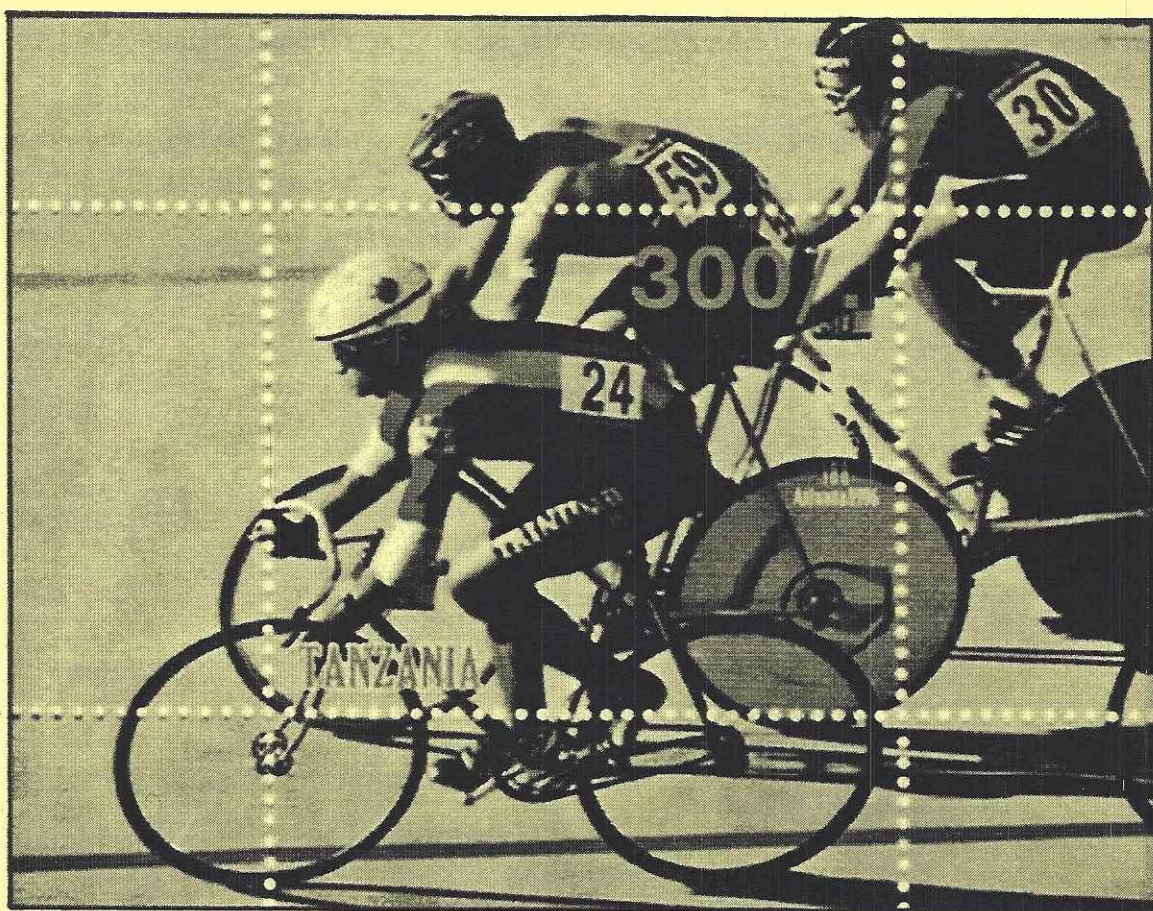

A stamp for Eddy Merckx - BELGIUM 14.06.2010

A stamp for the 65th Birthday Anniversary of Eddy Merckx

Belgium Post celebrates the 65th birthday of the greatest sportsman of the twentieth Belgian century by devoting a special stamp. On June 17 Eddy Merckx celebrates his 65st birthday, three days before this milestone the post office will issue a special stamp to pay tribute to Belgium's greatest cyclist of all time.

On April 22nd 2010, within the walls of the Stamp Printing in Mechelen that the managing director of La Poste, Johnny Thys, introduced the special stamp to Eddy Merckx, his family, his friends including Paul Van Himst and several of his former teammates like Patrick Sercu, Herman Van Springel and Fons De Wolf. The event was enhanced by the presence of Prime Minister Yves Leterme, a great lover of cycling, and the Minister of Public Enterprises, Inge Vervotte. Johnny Thijs on that occasion said: "We are all proud of Eddy Merckx. With this special stamp to mark his 65th Birthday The Post honours the greatest Belgian sportsman ever".

Karl Meersman used two illustrations for the design of the stamp: one old and one of today. The stamp shows a typical and familiar image of the sportsman Eddy Merckx, in the yellow jersey, making a victory in front of the Arc de Triomphe.

The special stamp is printed on sheets of 5 stamps. As of June 14, the stamps will be in most post offices and can also be obtained via the web store of The Post. It costs 5.90 euros and the stamps bear the value "2" corresponding to non-standard mail for addresses in Belgian. The Merckx stamp is part of a series of stamps about sports. On the same day The Post also provides postal stamps on the World Cup and the Youth Olympics.

Belgium Post are also issuing a First Day Sheet and a FDC bearing the Merckx stamp.



Fausto Coppi — Gino Bartali

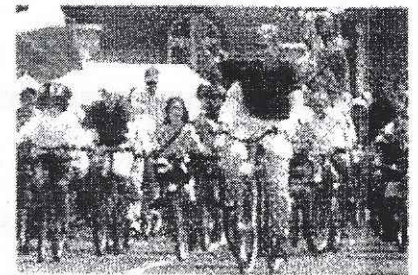
The diptych commemorates the 50th and 10th anniversaries of the deaths of Gino Bartali (1914-2000) and Fausto Coppi (1919-1960). In the centre of the diptych is a sketch of Coppi and Bartali passing a water-bottle on a newspaper background; in the upper right hand side is the profile of Gino Bartali, and on the left, that of Fausto Coppi. To complete the stamp, Bartali's autograph on the right and Coppi's on the left. The stamps carry the captions "1919-1960", "1914-2000", "SAN MARINO", the values "1,50" and "1,40", the printing institute, the year of issue and the artist's name, "M. ANTOPELLI"

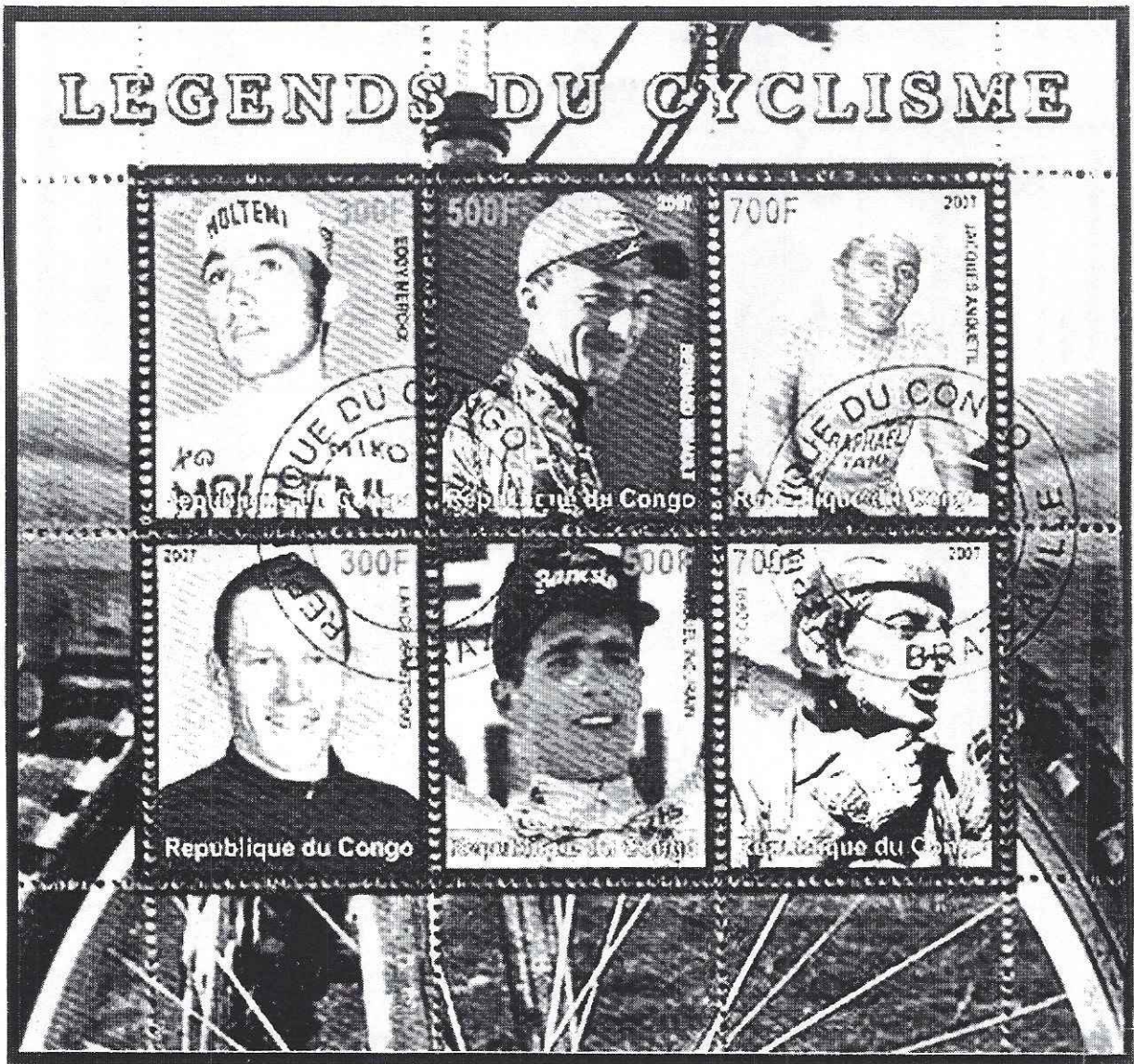

SAN MARINO - 20.02.2009 - CENTENARY OF THE FUTURIST MANIFESTO

On February, 20th, 1909, the Futurist manifesto appeared on the Paris newspaper Le Figaro, written by Filippo Tommaso Marinetti. In the context of the battle against academicism, then rife, there were many rejuvenation attempts by artists from different fields at the beginning of the 20th century, and all were generally backed by a "manifesto" explaining the reasons, the ends and the methods used. Marinetti's revealed itself to be the most radical, due to the complete break from tradition, via the exaltation of mechanized and industrialised society, the mythologization of a movement and vitality without boundaries, and the involvement of every expressive form and human activity, as the numerous "manifestos" (the last is dated 1929) dedicated to painting, music, the theatre and so on, up to the "futurist political party" reveal. A movement, which, even having reached its greatest results in the figurative arts, left a trace everywhere, including fashion and architecture, and had a strong influence on contemporary and later artistic movements, from Cubism to Surrealism to Dadaism, throughout the whole of Europe and the world. The souvenir sheet by Franco Filanci, which San Marino dedicates to Futurism, exactly a century after, doesn't just celebrate the most famous works of this fundamental movement, but proposes to relive its spirit via anarchic dynamism and global interest, with the creation of that which can be considered a "Futuristic souvenir sheet": where stamps of different sizes and layout are surrounded by Futuristic concepts and keywords in a "concise and alogical" way, even with "free perforations". The stamps present Futurism's main themes: dynamism, with a vertical sequence which ranges from Giacomo Balla's "Dog on a leash", Carlo Carrà's "Red Horseman", up to Umberto Boccioni's cyclist: heroic modernism, with Gino Severini's "Armoured train"; industrial progress with Antonio Sant'Elia's "Electric power plant". And, at the same time, the rejuvenated expressive forms: paintings, with a "Still life" collage by Ardengo Soffici; sculpture, with Boccioni's "Unique forms of continuity in space"; literature, with Marinetti's free words; music, with Luigi Russolo's "Intonarumori" (noise machine) and relative score; the theatre, with a Futuristic evening depicted in a sketch by Boccioni; "handmade" cinema, with a frame of "The Futurist life" by Marinetti and Arnaldo Ginna; objects, with Giacomo Balla's "Smoke cabinet", the last two in the margin, together with a group photograph of the most important exponents of the movement. With the citation – a seal but not a stamp – by Fortunato Depero, one of the continuers of the movement, active in the postwar period, especially in the graphic and advertising field. The souvenir sheet, with relative stamps, has been created by Franco Filanci, revising and citing works and texts by Balla, Boccioni, Carrà, Depero, Ginna, Marinetti, Russolo, Sant'Elia, Severini and Soffici.



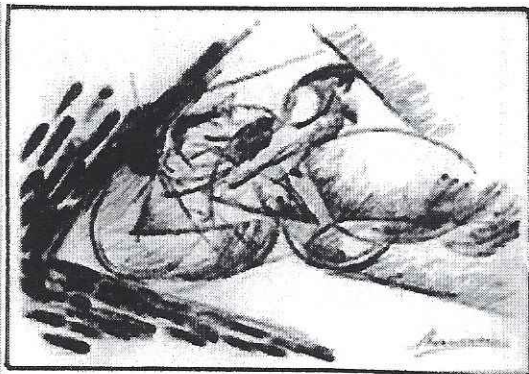

I found it in "Michel Rundschau", the "Newsletter" from Michel catalogue, when I read the description "Dynamik eines Radfahrers" that means "Dynamism of a cyclist". A painting from Umberto Boccioni. But I could not see any cyclist. It is an issue of San Marino from 20 February 2009, Centenary of the Futurist Manifesto.

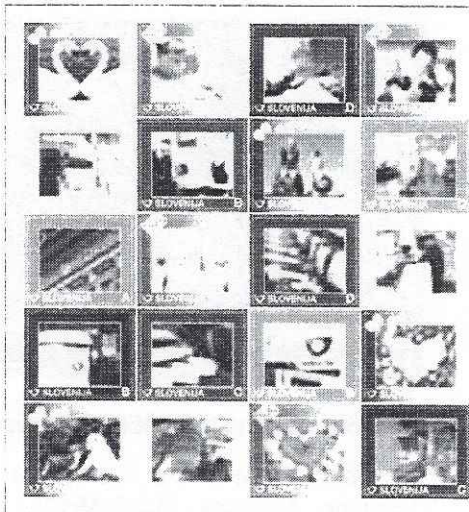

Personalised Stamps

As we have informed you, Posta Slovenije issued four sheets of personalised postage stamps on 27th November, 2009. The designs were varied and interesting, and some of them have been used for the first time on Slovenian postage stamps (postal vehicles and facilities, moments from the postal traffic etc.).

All the stamps are presented in philatelic catalogues (Michel, Slovenika etc.), prepared in a catalogue on the website wnsstamps.ch, and are also expected in pre-printed album sheets from different producers. Therefore, we advise you again not to postpone the purchase of these stamps, since the edition is limited to only 40,000 items. The above-mentioned stamps may be ordered by using the enclosed Order Form.

Personalisierte Briefmarken

Wie Sie bereits wissen, liebe Leserinnen und Leser, Briefmarkensammlerinnen und -sammler, haben wir am 27. November 2009 vier Bögen mit je 20 verschiedenen personalisierten Briefmarken herausgegeben. Die Auswahl der Motive ist wirklich großartig und darunter gibt es Motive, die zum ersten Mal auf den slowenischen Briefmarken dargestellt sind und die die vielen verschiedenen Gesichter der Slowenischen Post präsentieren.

Alle diese Briefmarken wurden bereits in verschiedenen philatelistischen Katalogen (Michel, Slovenika, ...) vorgestellt und auch auf der Webseite www.wnsstamps.ch registriert (WNS ist ein weltweites Nummerierungssystem für Postwertzeichen) und mit den WNS-Nummern versehen. Es ist zu erwarten, dass verschiedene Hersteller bald auch Vordruck-Albumblätter für diese Briefmarken auf den Markt bringen.

Da die neuen personalisierten Briefmarken in einer niedrigeren Auflage gedruckt wurden, als es sonst üblich ist (nur 40.000 Stück), möchten wir Ihnen empfehlen, sich rechtzeitig alle vier Bögen zu sichern (s. Bestellschein).

German modern private post stamps

You all know the German local posts of the 19th century in Frankfurt, Bochum and Hamburg and their bicycle/tricycle stamps. They all had to stop their business until 31.3.1900 because of the Reichs-Postmonopol (post monopoly of German Reich) which started on 1.4.1900. After this time it was not allowed for a private company to transport letters. All companies in this business got a compensation and had to stop it.

In the course of the deregulation of the post market in the European Union the market in Germany was opened in 1998 for private letter carriage again and the first companies were established nearly 100 years after establishing the monopoly (http://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/German_letter_monopoly engl.)

Nowadays the German Wikipedia divides the German postal services in national and local post companies (<http://de.wikipedia.org/wiki/Postunternehmen> germ.). National companies are only a few like Deutsche Post (the "old" state-owned one, today a stock corporation), TNT, PIN Group or Hermes (all private). The local companies are too many to be listed here. Many of these existed for only short periods. A thread of the BDPH forum (Federation of German Philatelists) shows lists and other information about these companies: <http://www.bdph.de/forum/showthread.php?t=5674> (germ.).

They all do need a licence by the "Bundesnetzagentur" (Federal Network Agency for deregulation of telecommunications, electricity, gas, railways and postal service, <http://www.bundesnetzagentur.de>) and the agency publishes lists of the concluded licences.

Up to now ca. 150 (!) of these companies have issued stamps. Michel, the German catalogue publisher has issued a catalogue: "Michel Katalog Band II Moderne Privatpost" (2006). This is the standard for the "German modern private post stamps".

Expectedly some of these companies published bicycle stamps. Even though I am collecting only cycling sport stamps in this case I tried to find out anything about bicycle stamps. I'm sure, that I haven't found all of them and I do not own all these stamps I have found. Some of the pictures are from pricelists (Haller Briefmarken) or from the internet with a poor standard of quality. Surely there are existing more cancellations and maybe labels but they are difficult to find.

I have described the items I've found like the following pattern:

Name of the postal service

city or area of delivery, other information about the postal service
date of issue - "subject" - Michel number
classification, information about the issue

In some cases I'm not sure about the classification. I'm not sure whether a sportive bike courier is a sport stamp or not (rather not). Or if all mass events are "sport for all". In dubio pro reo?

The "Steep Wall"

The "Steep Wall" (German: "Steile Wand") is the most famous street in Meerane. It is a landmark and also an important conservation area within the town. There is a difference in height of 30m along the street's 238m. The spectacular mountain racing classification for the street has made the „Steep Wall“ of Meerane famous. Known for its use in



international cycling races, it has Wilhelminian style ("Gründerzeit") architecture on both sides and was declared a historic monument.



Cyclists all over the world know (and fear) the "Wall". The 13 % gradient has forced many a cyclist (and not only them) to dismount and carry his or her bike to the top. Since 1952 cycling up the street was incorporated into the "Peace Race" which came to Meerane once a year. Today cyclists or drivers of vintage cars taking part in the Interanational Tour of Saxony, the Tour of Germany or the SachsenClassic race try to conquer the "Steep Wall". The original name was "Bergstraße" (sic!

"Oudebergstraat" is the real name of "de muur") but after reporters and fans of the "Peace Race" called it "Steile Wand" it was renamed in the "50's" into "An der steilen Wand".

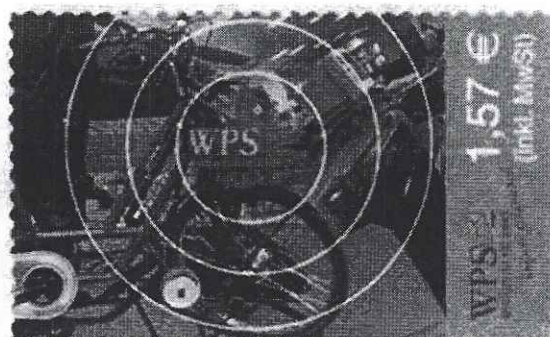
