Editorial

I will be sorry to lose him as Assistant Treasurer because he collects subscriptions in dollars and only sends a lump sum to me, when necessary. Although I accept Euro payments for subscriptions, it is more difficult to accept dollars due to the fluctuating exchange rate and the high charges imposed by British banks when paying in dollars. My main efforts were concentrated on the production of "Bicycle Stamps" after the unexpected death of Tony Teideman, who did so much for the Club. Two items of postal stationery submitted by Arnoldt Rehm are illustrated. Arnoldt has also requested that a bigger effort be made to encourage members to accept "Bicycle Stamps in an electronic form because:-

There would be a saving in time and labour (printing/handling/shipping)

The ability to use "copy and paste" in case of links

All images will be seen in colour

No storage space needed for back issues of the magazine

A reduction in the subscription should be possible.

Whilst I accept that all these arguments, I struggle to keep up in this computer age. What do you think?

Piet Hein Hilarides maintains a Bicycle Stamps Check list. He has advised me recently that he was pleased to receive useful information on new issues from member Michel Leseueur. Thank you Michel.

A further selection of special postmarks for the Berlin Warsaw Prague 'Peace race' are included together with illustrations of some of the stamps issued. The stamp details are provided by Roy Régent, in French. The stamps were illustrated previously in BS 59 May 2007 in an article by Tony Howes, in English.

2014 is the 30th anniversary of the British Thematic Association and a note on Bicycle displays at Spring Stampex in London is included. More importantly 2014 marks the 100th anniversary of the First World War. I am showing blocks of poster stamps from Germany and Italy on the front and back of this issue.

I wish to thank Thomas Matthies, Arnoldt Rehm and Régent Roy for providing material for this issue. Ernie Clayton also sent me a lot of cuttings and photographs, which I will include in future issues.

Thank you also to those members who have renewed their subscriptions in the last six months.

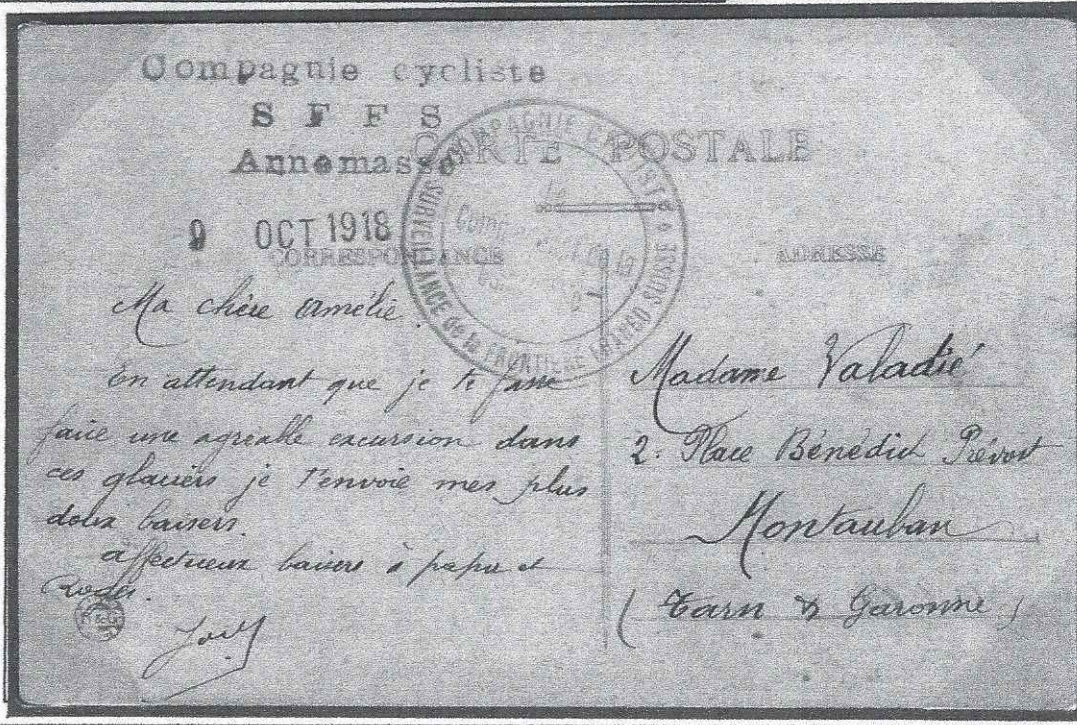

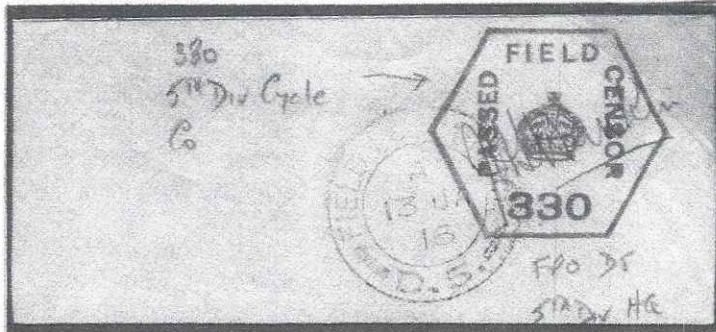

ITALIAN POSTER STAMPS

Three similar blocks of 10 labels are illustrated, but in brown green and violet, on pages 54-56 of *POSTER STAMPS: BICYCLES: WORLD:2011* by Charles Kiddle and published by World Poster Stamps, PO Box 13, Alton, Hants GU34 4DW, UK e-mail charleskiddle@btconnect.com

In an earlier edition of *BICYCLES OF THE WORLD EXCLUDING GERMANY 2002 Revised Edition*, nine poster stamps in a mixture of four colours were illustrated. It was assumed that these were the colours of the specific poster stamps.

However three mint blocks of ten were discovered in an 'old time' collection in 2009, in the identical design to that on the left, which is in blue.

To quote from Charles Kiddle's book

"It is known that there are 5 colours and it is possible that 'black' may exist" (ie brown, blue, green red and violet) "From the illustrated blocks it can be seen that each design exists twice, one larger than the other...These are important WW1 poster stamps"
